

STATEMENT OF COMMITMENT UPON BEING AN ACTIVE DEACON

Having been nominated by the Deacon Nominating Committee to become an active Deacon, beginning January 1, 2024, I have examined myself and have sought the Lord's leadership, and agree to allow my name to be presented to the Church for consideration in selecting me as a Deacon for an active term in this Church, and in doing so:

- I will earnestly seek the Lord's direction in every area of my life, including the use of my time, my material possessions, my unique abilities, and my influence to both serve the Lord and project a positive Christian example in His Kingdom here on earth and through this Church. Further, I will continuously examine the quality of my spiritual life to assure that I walk in the light as He is in the light at all times. In so doing, I will endeavor to avoid sin at every turn and, as needed, seek forgiveness and repent as Christ commanded. I will also take care that, in exercising my personal freedom, I do not become a stumbling block to other brothers and sisters, so that I may live in continuous fellowship with Him.
- I acknowledge my responsibility and commit myself to faithfully and regularly attend Sunday School and morning and evening Worship Services on the Lord's Day and other activities of the week as much as my family and work responsibilities will allow, and to faithfully support the budget of this Church.
